On MOTION by Mr. Penzer seconded by Ms. Grandon with all in favor adding the new furniture, fixtures, carpets, renovations, etc. to the joint maintenance reserve in the amount of \$39,879 was approved.

- o A cost estimate for the Multi-Purpose Park was handed out and we cannot get a contractor as they do not have the time. Ms. Jackson and Mr. Hayford will coordinate the project as project managers.

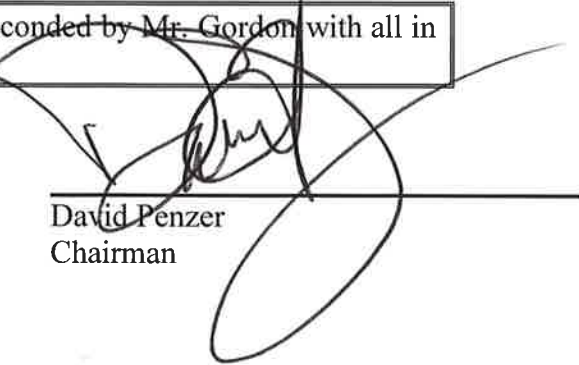
Adjournment
